ORDINANCE NO. 198

NUISANCE AND JUNKYARD ORDINANCE (AMENDING AND CONSOLIDATING FORMER ORDINANCES NOS. 160, 154, 192 AND 196).

AND NOW, this 16th day of September, 1997, the Supervisors of Glade Township, Warren County, Pennsylvania, do hereby Enact and Ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Glade Township are by virtue of the Laws and Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including the provisions of the Act of 1957, May 20, P.L. 174, Section 5, 53 P.S. Section 65712, and the Act of 1963, August 24, P.L. 1197, Section 1, 53 P.S. Section 65758, both as may be amended, empowered to prohibit nuisances and regulate the maintenance of junkyards; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Glade Township have previously adopted Ordinance No. 160, Ordinance No. 192 and Ordinance No. 196 pertaining to nuisances, as well as Ordinance No. 154 relating to junkyards; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Glade Township seek to consolidate the foregoing Ordinances into one Ordinance and further to amend the same by updating definitions, increasing penalties and the like; and

WHEREAS, the abandonment and maintenance of garbage, rubbish, buildings, structures, automobiles, junk, old machinery, used building materials, rubble and other articles unsuitable to the uses for which they were originally intended have created and will create private and public nuisances, rendering it difficult to keep public and private
